# Please Be Aware Of Or Be Reminded That...

• The school is very busy before and after school especially in the first couple of weeks of September. Schools now have to adhere to very strict timings (the times sent out on Monday). This will mean that Reception Year 1 and 2 doors must close at 8.45am (3.15pm finish) and the Main Yard gates will be closed at 8.50am (3.20pm finish for Years, 3,4,5 and 6). All doors in the morning will be open from 8.40am.

If you are late, you will need to come around to the Main Office entrance.

- You are responsible for your child before they enter and leave school at the beginning and end
  of the day...please do not allow your child to ride bikes or scooters on the yard or climb on
  anything (trees, railings etc).
- If you've not done so already, please name all clothing, especially jumpers, cardies and coats.
- Please do not comment negatively about the school on social media. If there is a problem, it needs resolving with <u>us</u>. Come and see myself, Mr Jessop or Mrs Ramsden or talk to any staff member...even if it means waiting until a Monday. Thank you in advance especially with this, we've got so good with this over the years. Thank you for your help with this.
- Please do not park across any residents driveways and on any local business forecourts (in particular, Nicola's and Sparkles) at pick up and drop off. It's not our responsibility to police this but we really need to maintain community harmony. Wardens regularly patrol the area now and a number of fines were issued last year.
- No dogs on the yard please, not even cute ones. Please do not tie dogs up at the gates. Sorry!
- Breakfast and After School Club—Please note that this begins at 7.30am. It is essential that all pick ups are made by 5.30pm. Please see Mrs Selby in our Hive building for all details and bookings.

# Attendance and Punctuality

It is important that your child aspires to achieve the best attendance at school as possible, arriving on time and ready to learn every day. Establishing a strong routine of punctuality and attendance goes a long way to form a positive attitude towards school and supports achievement across the curriculum.

As ever, we are unable to authorise holidays in term times (except in exceptional circumstances) - any unauthorised absences could lead to a penalty notice.

This year we will be monitoring attendance particularly closely, especially unauthorised absences where we do not have a reason for children being off. If you know your child is going to be absent from school, please contact the school office and inform us on the first day.

A series of unauthorised absences could also lead to a fixed penalty notice being issued.

"Avoid the fine - drop us a line!"

It would be helpful if, when making appointments for dentist and medical appointments, that these are made outside of school times, where possible.
