Attendance

It is vitally important that your child attends school regularly and on time and with this in mind, we will be working hard this year to ensure that attendance in school is the best it can be, following the difficult years of COVID

We aim for our school target to fall no lower than 97%. Any individual child whose attendance drops below 90% is deemed a 'persistent absentee'; their subsequent attendance is tracked throughout the year.

Obviously children become ill and need time off school. If this is the case, please follow our absence procedures.

It is crucial that you contact school on the first day of absence; please speak to someone or leave a message. When your child is fit to return to school, please send them in with a note to explain their absence. Un-authorised absences and absences without reason will be followed up and could trigger the involvement of an Education Welfare Officer or lead to a Fixed Penalty Notice.
